While yields were overall lower than our ten-year average, the quality of the fruit was sensational across the board.

WINEMAKING

Machine harvested in the cool of the night the fruit was then crushed and pressed. Once the clear juice had settled, it was racked and inoculated with an aromatic yeast strain and fermented cool. Once ferment was finished the wine remained on lees for a couple of months before being prepared for bottling.
